Why Management Plans



A management plan

- Describes how to protect the key biodiversity, share responsibilities, allocate available funds and how to monitor the impact of the management activities.
- Is needed to be accountable and transparent about the allocation of funds.
- A bases for visitor management.
- A bases for designing proposals to attract extra funding for investments in restoration or for mitigating environmental stress
