Article 1 – Registration fee

Registration is invitation-only and available for a limited number of participants. The registration deadline is 30 November 2021. The registration fee is a fee to partially cover the costs of the event. The fee is €100,- for Eurosite non-members and 50 € for Eurosite members and friends of Eurosite (plus the Eventbrite handling fee). The registration fee covers local transport between the conference venues/excursion sites, accommodation for the nights of Monday 6 and Tuesday 7 December, and meals during the event. The fee does not cover travel to and from the conference venue and accommodation before or after the event. The registration fee is a limited offer made available on a first-come-first-serve basis. Eurosite retains the right to close registration for the event at any point, depending on the availability of funds.

Article 2 – General conditions and payment

Participants can register their attendance solely by using the Eventbrite website. Payment of the fee is due upon registration. After the submission of the registration, you will receive a confirmation of your registration.

Article 3 - Cancellation and reimbursement

In case of cancellation of the event by Eurosite, the full registration fee (excluding the Eventbrite handling fee) will be reimbursed to the participants. The same is true should a participant need to cancel participation due to a change in Covid-19 restrictions in his/her home country. Any costs related travel arrangements made by the participant or accommodation costs outside the nights covered by registration fee will not be reimbursed by Eurosite. Make sure to buy train/flight tickets that allow for a reimbursement in case of cancellation of the travel due to changing Covid restrictions.

Article 4 - VISA

It is in the responsibility of the participants to obtain a visa for entry into Spain if necessary. The same goes for any obligatory documentation for admission in relation to Covid-19 (e.g. a negative CPR-test, proof of vaccination etc.). Eurosite is not to be held responsible if participants are denied entry into Spain. Information for travel requirements regarding Covid-19 is available here: <https://reopen.europa.eu/en>.

Article 5 - Insurance

Participants are responsible for their own medical, travel and personal insurance. They are advised to ensure that they have adequate insurance cover at their own expense or at the expense of their nominating organisation for accidents, sickness, disability and death, as well as third party risk for the duration of the event. Eurosite will not accept any responsibility or liability in such contingencies.

Article 6 - Covid-19 safety protocol

The following Covid-19 safety protocol will be applied upon arrival at the conference venue: Participants will only be granted permission to enter the venue after showing either a negative PCR test no older than 72 hours, a vaccination certificate or proof of recovery from Covid-19.
